St Basils young people and staff meet Ozzy and Sharon Osbourne.

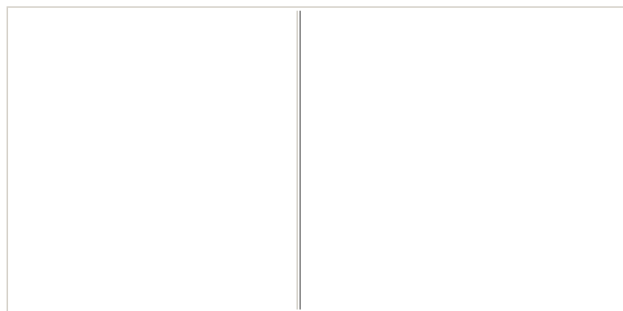
