Youthline is a partnership between 5 organisations:  
Bromford, Maypole Centre, Moseley and District, St  
Basils and Trident Reach .

Youthline ensures access to a range of high quality  
support services which prevent youth homelessness  
and will support you to find and keep a home.

**Youthline is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.**

Calls to 03 numbers cost the same as calls to standard geographic numbers (i.e. those beginning 01 or 02). Calls to 03 numbers **must** also be included in any inclusive call minute packages or discount schemes offered by fixed and mobile network operators and from payphones.

## WHAT DOES YOUTHLINE OFFER?

Calling Youthline is your first step to accessing the support you need.

If you are homeless our support workers will help you to find alternative accommodation that suits your needs.



If you are at risk of becoming homeless we can help to prevent you from losing your accommodation.

Our support workers can also assist you to achieve the skills you need to live independently so that you do not lose your home in future.

We can help you to look for a job, voluntary work or training.

We can support you to improve difficult family relationships so that you do not become lonely or isolated.

Tell us about any problems that could lead to you becoming homeless and we will support you to sort them out.

Just call the Youthline and speak to one of our trained and experienced workers. They are friendly and approachable, will put you first and do their very best to ensure you are safe and not at risk.
